Judges:

- 1. The best speaker should be given the rank of 1.
- 2. No two speakers may be given the same rank.
- 3. Time Limit: Maximum of ten (10) minutes with no minimum. There is a mandatory thirty (30) second grace period during which time no penalty may be assessed. Speakers that exceed this grace period may not be ranked first in the round.
- 4. Material shall be from al least two of the following three genres: prose, poetry, and drama.
- 5. The selection(s) must be read from a manuscript. The manuscript may be used as a prop, as long as the speaker maintains control of it at all times.
- 6. Speakers may walk and gesture during the performance.

The contestant should also be evaluated on how effective their argument/theme is projected in the total program. In developing a creative, thematic program, attention should be given to the design and organization of a cohesive and carefully conceived whole by linking authors and ideas inherent in the literature.
